



## 2017 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT "MAKEOVER MONTPELIER"

As I'm sure you all know by now, Montpelier is having a Makeover! Beginning in early May, the City will mobilize various construction projects on State Street, Spring Street, Elm Street, Taylor Street, Northfield Street, Main Street, and Memorial Drive. We are committed to keeping all residents informed with regular updates as outlined below.

Most of the construction downtown will occur at *night* with the exception of sidewalk work. Please see the noise ordinance reminder below. The reconstruction of Northfield Street and paving on VT Route 12 from just north of Spring Street to Mill Road will occur during *daytime* work hours.

Francine Perkins of FRP Enterprises will be the Project Outreach Coordinator working with VTrans and the City of Montpelier to develop and implement a comprehensive project communication outreach plan. Just a reminder: At their regular meeting on February 8, 2017, the Montpelier City Council passed a waiver of the City's **Noise Ordinance** to be implemented during the upcoming downtown construction projects. The noise ordinance waiver locations are as follows:

- Main Street - Memorial Drive to Kellogg-Hubbard Library (9:00 pm – 7:00 am);
- Main Street - Library to and including the Roundabout (9:00 pm-Midnight);
- Spring Street - Roundabout through Elm Street intersection (9:00 pm – Midnight);
- State Street – Main Street to 200 ft west of Bailey Avenue (9:00 pm – 7:00 am);
- Bailey Avenue – 200 ft either side of State Street intersection (9:00 pm – 7:00 am);
- Berlin/Main/Memorial/Northfield Street intersection to School Avenue on the east, and to 100 ft on other approaches (9:00 pm – 7:00 am). *This work may be deferred until Spring 2018.*
