

Tonight (5/17) and tomorrow night (5/18), crews will be paving the first of two courses of new pavement. The paving plan is contingent upon favorable weather conditions. If it rains, paving will be canceled and rescheduled.

Wednesday Night (5/17) State Street and Main Street–

- Paving crews will spend the first half of the night shift paving all of State Street.
- The second half of the night shift, crews will be paving on Main Street between the rail crossing and School Street.
- Line striping will follow paving.

Street parking will be blocked off in all locations with active paving operations. Alternating one-way traffic will be used to maintain traffic flow around construction operations.

Thursday night (5/18) Main Street between School St and the Roundabout –

Paving crews will pave Spring Street, the roundabout and Main Street to School Street along with any side street entrances that remain unpaved. Work will start at 5:00 pm.

Roundabout Detour - Due to the constrained working area in the roundabout area, while work is occurring from School Street to the Roundabout, passenger vehicles wanting to use the roundabout will be directed to an alternate route marked with signs.

- Main St [north / south] - Passenger vehicles will be directed to use **School Street** and **Loomis Street**.
- Trucks (tractor units) will not be directed to use the School Street/Loomis Street detour to access County Road and/or Main Street. They will be held at the roundabout until equipment is cleared and then directed through.
- Trucks (tractor units) on Main Street wanting to access VT 12/Elm Street will be directed to use School Street to Elm Street.

Local traffic will have access to all businesses and/or residents between School Street and the roundabout while the detour is in use.

Street parking will be blocked off in all locations with active paving operations.
