

CHAPTER 10

MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

ARTICLE IV. TURNING MOVEMENT REGULATIONS

Sec. 10-400. U-TURNS.

The driver of any vehicle shall not turn such vehicle so as to proceed in the opposite direction within the following streets:

- (a) State Street, from its intersection with Main Street west to its intersection with Bailey Avenue.
- (b) Main Street, from its intersection with Memorial Drive north to its intersection with Spring Street.
- (c) Loomis Street, between Park Avenue and School Street.

Sec. 10-401. OBEDIENCE TO NO-TURN SIGNS.

Whenever authorized traffic signs are erected by authority of the city council indicating that no right turn or left turn or U-turn are permitted, it shall be unlawful for a driver of a vehicle to disobey the direction on any such sign.

Sec. 10-402. OBEDIENCE TO NO ENTRY SIGNS.

Whenever authorized traffic signs are erected by authority of the city council indicating that no entry by vehicle is permitted, it shall be unlawful for a driver of a vehicle to disobey the direction on any such sign.
