

CHAPTER 10

MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

ARTICLE VI. SPECIAL STOPS

Sec. 10-600. VEHICLES TO STOP AT STOP SIGNS.

When stop signs are erected as authorized by the City Council, every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, in the event there is no crosswalk shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway before the driver has view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection except when directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic-control signal and then shall proceed so as not to interfere with traffic.

Sec. 10-601. EMERGING FROM ALLEY, DRIVEWAY OR BUILDINGS.

The driver of a vehicle within a business or residence district emerging from an alley, driveway, or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto a sidewalk or onto the sidewalk area extending across any alleyway or driveway, yielding the right-of-way to any pedestrian as may be necessary to avoid collision, and upon entering the roadway shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles approaching on said roadway.

Sec. 10-602. YIELD SIGN.

When yield signs are erected as authorized by the City Council, all vehicles upon approaching such a sign shall do so at a reasonable and safe speed. Prior to entering such a posted intersection, each operator shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle approaching the intersection or already within the intersection, unless directed otherwise by a law enforcement officer.

Sec. 10-603. TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL.

All vehicle operators shall obey directions given by officially erected traffic control devices. Official traffic control signals of the various colors and arrows of direction, and posted signs indicating directions and traffic control shall be obeyed unless directed otherwise by a law enforcement officer.
