

CHAPTER 10

MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

ARTICLE V. ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS

Sec. 10-500. AUTHORITY TO PLACE ONE-WAY STREET SIGNS.

Whenever any ordinance of this city designates any one-way street, signs shall be placed and maintained giving notice thereof, and no such regulation shall be effective unless such signs are in place. Signs indicating the direction of lawful traffic movement shall be placed at every intersection where movement of traffic in the opposite direction is prohibited.

Sec. 10-501. ONE-WAY STREETS.

In accordance with Section 10-500 of this Article, when properly signposted, all vehicular traffic shall pass on the following streets only in the direction indicated and not otherwise:

- (a) Cedar Street - northerly, between East State Street and School Street.
- (b) Hubbard Street - southerly, between East State Street and First Avenue.
- (c) Langdon Street - westerly, between Main Street and Elm Street.
- (d) Parkway - northwesterly, between Spring and Winter Streets, above 2 Summer Street between April 1 through November 1.
- (e) Bingham Street - northeasterly between East State Street and house number 9.
- (f) Baldwin Street - westerly from Western Avenue to Hopkins Street.
- (g) Stone Cutters Way - southeasterly, from a point located 240' southeast of Main Street and extending for a distance of 800'.
