

ARTICLE IV. ADVERTISING

Sec. 11-400. POSTING BILLS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

No person shall post or display a showbill, advertisement, or paper, or make, paint, or otherwise portray a sign, advertisement, or notice on a building, wall, fence, post, or stone, without the consent of the owner or person in charge thereof if on private property.

Sec. 11-401. INDECENT ADVERTISING.

No person shall post or display an indecent, immodest, or obscene showbill, advertisement, or paper, or make, paint, or otherwise portray an indecent, immodest, or obscene sign, advertisement, notice or other thing, on a building, wall, fence, post, stone or sidewalk, or in any other manner exhibit the same to the public.

Sec. 11-402. POSTING BILLS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.

No person shall place, post or maintain in or upon a street, public place, common, or park any sign, notice, advertisement, or poster, or on any building, wall, fence, pole, post, stone, or tree therein. But this section shall not be construed as relating to acts done by the permission of the City Council under the provisions of any ordinance, nor to acts done by municipal or other officers in the performance of official duty.
