

CHAPTER 12

CEMETERIES

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 12-1. DESTRUCTION IN.

It shall be unlawful for any person to destroy, injure, deface or remove any tree, shrub, foliage, vine or flower or any vase, pot, headstone or monument, fence or other structure in any burial ground or cemetery.

Sec. 12-2. PENALTY.

Any person convicted of violation of Sec. 12-1 of this Article shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of this Code in Sec. 1-9.
