NATURAL RESOURCES

ARTICLE II. RIVERS AND STREAMS

Sec. 13-200. ENCROACHMENT ON RIVER.

No person shall in any manner encroach upon the bed of the North Branch or of the Winooski River within the city, nor restrict the flowage thereof by filling, or by placing or depositing any material upon, th banks thereof, or by any other means whatsoever; provided, however, that this section shall not be construed to affect the lawful development or use of any water power thereon, or the acts of the city council in the interests of the public welfare.

Sec. 13-201. LITTER IN RIVER.

No person shall place or deposit in the water, or upon ice formed thereof, or upon the banks of the North Branch or of the Winooski River within the city any rubbish or waste material of any kind.
