

CHAPTER 9

LICENSES

ARTICLE XII. ITINERANT PHOTOGRAPHERS

Sec. 9-1200. LICENSE REQUIRED.

Each natural person who practices the profession of an itinerant photographer in the city of Montpelier, whether as principal, agent or servant and whether engaged in soliciting or in one or more of the operations involved in the making of photographic pictures or reproductions, shall obtain a license as hereinafter provided.

Sec. 9-1201. ITINERANT PHOTOGRAPHER DEFINED.

For the purpose of this chapter "itinerant photographer" means a person, partnership or corporation having no regularly established place of business in this state who personally or by agents or servants goes from town to town or from place to place within a town soliciting the making of photographic pictures or reproduction with a view to selling the same to the persons solicited.

Sec. 9-1202. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.

Before a license is granted, an application signed by the applicant shall be presented to the City Clerk on forms furnished. The applicant must also exhibit to the City Clerk the original license issued to him by the State of Vermont.

Sec. 9-1203. LICENSE FEE.

The applicant shall pay a license fee to the City of Montpelier in the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) which license shall be in effect until April 1 net after the date thereof.

Sec. 9-1204. ORDERS TAKEN BY LICENSEE.

All orders taken by a licensee shall be in writing and be in duplicate, and set forth the name and address of the licensee, his state and city license number, the terms of the order, and the delivery date. The original of such order shall be delivered to the purchaser at the time the order is taken.

Sec. 9-1205. WHEN LICENSEE MAY ACCEPT PAYMENT.

No licensee shall accept payment for any order in advance, or until after delivery pursuant to such order and acceptance by the purchaser, after an opportunity for inspection of the work ordered.

Sec. 9-1206. SHOWING LICENSE: PENALTY FOR REFUSAL.

A person licensed to practice the profession of itinerant photographer in the city who refuses to show his license upon request shall be fined not more than \$50.00.
