

CHAPTER 9

LICENSES

ARTICLE X. GASOLINE STATIONS.

Sec. 9-1000. LICENSE REQUIRED.

Every person, firm or corporation maintaining in any public street, lane or alley in the city a pump or pumps for the sale of gasoline, diesel fuel or other such products for sale to the public shall annually obtain a license therefore.

Sec. 9-1001. LICENSE FEE.

The annual fee for such license shall be thirty-five dollars (\$35.00).
