

ARTICLE XX. THEATERS, STAGE SHOWS

Sec. 9-2000. LICENSE REQUIRED.

No person shall conduct a theater, moving picture show or stage show within the city limits until he has have first obtained a license therefore; this requirement shall not be construed so as to affect school, religious or fraternally sponsored events.

Sec. 9-2001. LICENSE FEE.

The fees for such license shall be as follows: With a seating capacity not exceeding two hundred fifty persons, one hundred dollars (\$100.00); with a seating capacity exceeding two hundred fifty persons, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00); said fee may be paid in equal monthly installments in advance.
