### **The Problem with Drinking and Driving**

On Thursday, November 12, 2009, from 6:30 – 8:30 pm, the Montpelier Community Justice Center presents *Victim Impact: The True Cost of Drinking and Driving* at the Kellogg-Hubbard Library, Montpelier, Vermont. The program features a panel of three people from the Vermont Victim Impact Panel Program. Speakers with this program have been seriously injured or had family members killed or disabled in alcohol-related crashes. They tell the sad and painful stories of their losses in an effort to prevent future victims. Jim Bellino, former CRASH program director, will present information about what constitutes impaired driving and how to know when you are over the limit.

If you are someone who drives and who also drinks alcohol, by attending this program you will get a profound understanding of the cost of doing both at the same time and tips to help you make a responsible and safe choice instead.
