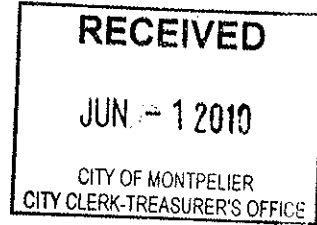

The Department of Liquor Control is concerned about the extent of alcohol beverage use by minors and in our efforts to prevent alcohol use by underage persons, we recently conducted a compliance check program to help determine the extent that retailers are selling alcohol beverage products to underage customers.

On May 24, 2010 at 5:24 p.m., an alcohol beverage sale was made to an underage person at your licensed premises. Our records indicate this is the **second** violation detected during an alcohol compliance test.

This letter is to inform you of the unlawful sale and of the importance of obeying the law and keeping alcohol beverages out of the hands of minors by routinely checking proper identification. General Regulation No. 13 of the Liquor Control Laws and Regulations clearly states that it is unlawful to sell alcohol beverages to anyone under the age of twenty-one.

The Liquor Control Board has directed me to offer licensees found in violation during compliance surveys an opportunity to settle the matter by accepting the following applicable penalty in lieu of hearing.


- 1st Offense ~ Letter of Warning
- 2nd Offense ~ \$300.00 administrative penalty or 3 day suspension of license.
- 3rd Offense ~ \$500.00 administrative penalty or 5 day suspension of license.
- 4th Offense ~ Hearing before the Liquor Control Board.

If you decide to waive your rights to a formal hearing and accept the 3 day suspension or \$300.00 administrative penalty, please sign the enclosed Waiver of Hearing form, and forward it to the Department of Liquor Control within 10 days of receiving this notice.

Mandatory training for the licensee and the employee who sold, is required within sixty (60) days.

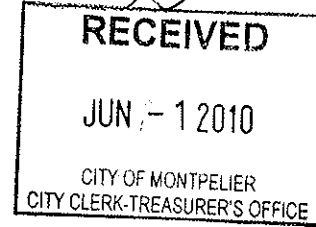

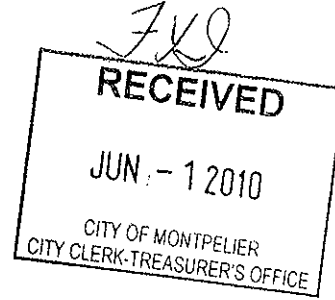
