You have indicated that the event will close by "sunset" and as long as the music ends by 9 p.m. you do not need a noise variance (which would require your going before the City Council and there is not enough time to meet that requirement. ) I specifically refer you to our Noise Ordinance requirement as found in Chapter 11, Article X Section 11-1000 to 11-1008 and more specifically to Sec. 11-1001 (h) in regards to the allowable decibel levels for sound from a particular source from 6 a.m to 9 p.m. (65).
