BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Due to the multiple water main breaks and associated boil water notices in Montpelier over the past few months, there has been growing concern from residents, business owners and council members about the overall condition of the water system.

The discussion will include short term work proposed to help mitigate water main breaks as well as the water system master plan for infrastructure replacement.
