

**Meeting of the Montpelier Board of Abatement**

**June 15, 2015, 5:00 PM (reconvened following recess at 6:15PM, June 24, City Council Chambers)**

**City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 39 Main Street**

Present: City Clerk John Odum, Justices of the Peace Jack McCullough, Nancy Sherman, Valerie Lewis, Nick Marro.

Present after recess: City Clerk John Odum, City Councilors Jean Olson, Justin Turcotte and Tom Golonka, City Treasurer Charlotte Hoyt, Justices of the Peace Jack McCullough, Nancy Sherman, Dan Richardson, Mary Hooper, Paul Carnahan, Philip Zalinger, Mary Alice Bisbee, and Page Guertin.

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The City Clerk, acting as Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:00PM, June 15.

Upon determining a quorum was not present, the Chair called for a recess (without objection) until 6:15PM, June 24, in the City Council Chambers.

At 6:15 on June 24 in the City Council Chambers, the Chair reconvened the meeting. At this time, Justices of the Peace Lewis and Marro did not return to the meeting, and the meeting was joined by City Councilors Jean Olson, Justin Turcotte and Tom Golonka, City Treasurer Charlotte Hoyt, and Justices of the Peace Dan Richardson, Mary Hooper, Paul Carnahan, Philip Zalinger, Mary Alice Bisbee, and Page Guertin.

Upon determination that a quorum was present, the Chair proceeded with business.

Mr. McCullough moved approval of the proposed agenda, and was seconded by Ms. Sherman. The motion carried unanimously at 6:16.

The Board of Abatement began consideration of the following requests for Abatement from Delinquent Tax Collector Beverlee Pembroke Hill:

- CHEP USA - \$127.68 (2013-2014)
- MARIOPOSA THERAPY - \$44.44 (2014-2015)
- MONTPELIER VILLAGE PIZZA - \$384.96 (2014-2015)
- THE VERMONT THRUSH RESTAURANT - \$1741.30 (2013-2014 and 2014-2015)

Ms. Hill provided background on the requests.

Mr. McCullough moved the Board grant the Abatements as requested by the Delinquent Tax Collector. Mr Richardson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

A brief discussion on an anticipated – but as yet unreceived – request for abatement followed.

Mr. Zalinger moved for adjournment, and was seconded by Mr. McCullough. The Chair answered a pair of procedural questions before calling for a vote on the motion, which carried unanimously at 6:26.
