

This survey was published on September 12, 2016 and closed on October 28, 2016. It was advertised on the City’s website, Front Porch Forum, the Bridge, and Facebook.

**Results**

- Who? 115 people took this survey
  - 17% live downtown
  - 54% work downtown
  - 44% play downtown
- What month? 67% want construction to take place in May and June
  - 20% in July and August
  - 13% in August and September
- What time? 64% want construction to happen between 6:00 pm and 6:00 am.

  - 48% Facebook
  - 44% City’s website
  - 41% Times Argus and the Bridge
  - 32% Dedicated email

<b>Recommendations on how the City can support them during construction?</b>
