

Construction Update
Montpelier Transportation Projects

Project Location: State Street, Main Street, and VT 12 – Elm Street - Work to include milling, paving, manhole and drainage structure adjustments and extensive sidewalk improvements. VT 12-Northfield Street - new water, sewer, storm water improvements, sidewalks and a stabilized road base.

Northfield Street Detour Routes – Effective Thursday, June 8th – Due to unexpected traffic impacts on the Northfield Street project, the following detour will remain in effect through October 2017-

- Dog River Road is marked as a truck detour route.
- Derby Drive is signed as detour route for traffic wanting to avoid the construction site.
- Alternating one-way local traffic will be maintained within the Northfield Street construction zone including any work on Memorial Drive.

Saturday, June 10, 2017 – Daytime sidewalk ramp work is planned for the crosswalk approaches at State Street and Taylor Street.

Memorial Drive/Northfield Street Intersection Night Work – In an effort to minimize traffic impacts and maintain daytime mobility, water and sewer infrastructure upgrades in the Memorial Drive/Northfield Street Intersection have been rescheduled to occur at night. The work is scheduled for Wednesday night (6/14) through Friday night (6/16). See details below.

Week of June 12th, 2017

Main Street –

Structure Adjustment-

- School Street to the Roundabout – Work Hours (5:00 pm – 12:00 am) – Crews are planning to work on adjusting existing manhole and drainage structures between School Street and the Roundabout. Typical equipment used for this work are saws and jackhammers.
- State Street to School Street – Night Work (7:00 pm to 7:00 am) – Crews will continue adjusting structures.

Sidewalks– (Work Hours – 7:00 pm to 11:00 am) Crews will work on replacing and upgrading the sidewalk ramps at various crosswalks along Main Street to School Street, including crosswalks at the

State & Main Street Intersection.

Sidewalk preparation work will be done overnight and the new concrete will be poured between 7:00 am and 11:00 am.

Street parking will be blocked off in active work areas and will be re-opened when work is completed.

State Street -

Day work - Daytime sidewalk construction is expected to be completed on State Street between Bailey Ave and Taylor Street this week.

Night work (7:00 pm – 11:00 am) –Crews will be replacing and upgrading the sidewalk ramps at all crosswalks on State Street between the Post Office and Main Street.

The preparation work will be done overnight and the new concrete will be poured between 7:00 am and 11:00 am.

Street parking will be blocked off in active work areas and will be re-opened when work is completed.

Northfield Street Update -

Traffic: The planned traffic detour using Derby Drive and Dog River Road is in now in effect through October 2017.

Day Work - Crews will continue working on the temporary water main during the early part of the week. Starting on Friday 6/9/2017 they will begin installing the temporary water main across driveways between #52 Northfield Street to Derby Drive. This work will continue on Monday and Tuesday of next week.

On Monday crews will also begin installing the temporary water main from Memorial Drive to #52 Northfield Street. A notice will be provided to residents whose driveways will be impacted at least 24 hours in advance of the work occurring. Access to and from driveways to be obstructed for approximately 1 hour. Access will be made available if needed in the case of an emergency.

There are no planned water interruptions this week.

Night Work - In an effort to minimize traffic impacts and maintain daytime mobility, water and sewer

infrastructure upgrades in and near the Memorial Drive/Northfield Street Intersection have been rescheduled to occur at night.

To complete the work in the intersection, night work is scheduled to start on Wednesday night (6/14) and extend through Friday night (6/16) between the hours of 6pm and 6 am.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
