

Construction Update Montpelier Transportation Projects

Project Location: State Street, Main Street, and VT 12 – Elm Street - Work to include milling, paving, manhole and drainage structure adjustments and extensive sidewalk improvements. VT 12-Northfield Street - new water, sewer, storm water improvements, sidewalks and a stabilized road base.

Northfield Street Detour – There are 3 active work zones within the project. Through traffic is strongly encouraged to use Derby Drive-National Life Drive-Memorial Drive as an alternate route. The alternate route for truck traffic is Dog River Road-Memorial Drive. Both routes are marked with signs.

Day Work will start on VT 12/Elm Street Monday (8/14). Expect traffic delays! See details below.

Week of August 14th, 2017

Day Work – (7:00 am to 9:00 pm, M-F)

VT 12/Elm Street – The project activities on Elm Street will be very similar to those on State Street and Main Street, except for the sidewalk replacement work. Crews will mill, pave 2 courses of new pavement, adjust structures and replace crosswalk ramps. Ditch lines will be cleaned and guardrail will be repaired on the north end of the project. Plans also call for widening of the western side of Elm Street between Cummings Street and North Park Street to accommodate for a new bike lane. Crews are estimating the Elm Street work to conclude in late September or early October, depending on the weather.

Monday (8/14) or Tuesday (8/15), milling operations will start at Spring Street and progress to the end of the project at the Montpelier/Middlesex town line.

Traffic - Travel will be reduced to one lane with alternating one-way traffic maintained by flaggers. Motorists can expect traffic delays all week.

Northfield Street Update

Sewer Installation – Installation of the new sewer main pipe will continue from #68 progressing towards Derby Drive.

Water Installation – Installation of the new water main will also continue this week from #56 Northfield Street toward Derby Street.

Service connections will continue this week. Advance notification will be provided for planned service interruptions.

Traffic – Alternating one-way traffic is anticipated all week. Motorists are strongly encouraged to seek alternative routes using Derby Drive or Dog River Road during construction. Traffic delays of up to 10 minutes can be expected on Northfield Street.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
