

## Montpelier Transportation Projects Construction Update

**Project Location:** State Street, Main Street, and VT 12 – Elm Street - Work to include milling, paving, manhole and drainage structure adjustments and extensive sidewalk improvements. VT 12-Northfield Street - new water, sewer, storm water improvements, sidewalks and a stabilized road base.

---

**Northfield Street: Weather permitting, Pike is tentatively scheduled to pave the base layer of new pavement on Northfield Street as early as Wednesday (11/8), pending weather conditions and completion of structure adjustments. If paving does not occur Wednesday, it will be rescheduled for Monday (11/13). Paving is expected to take approximately two days to complete.**

### Week of November 6th, 2017

#### **Elm Street –**

- Driveway entrances have been paved but are not complete. Crews will be placing topsoil and cleaning around entrances to bring them to completion.

#### **State and Main Streets –**

- Pike is coordinating with the line striping subcontractor to address punch list items on State and Main Streets. The date of the work is not confirmed but is expected to occur in the next few weeks.

**Traffic -** Travel will be reduced to one lane with alternating one-way traffic maintained by flaggers. Motorists can expect traffic delays all week.

#### **Northfield Street Update**

**Roadway:** Weather permitting, Pike is tentatively scheduled to pave the base layer of new pavement on Northfield Street as early as Wednesday (11/8), pending weather conditions and completion of structure adjustments. If paving does not occur Wednesday, it will be rescheduled for Monday (11/13). Fine grading of Northfield Street will be ongoing prior to paving.

**Curbing and Sidewalks:** Crews will continue sidewalk work in various areas, weather permitting.

**Structure Adjustments:** Structure adjustments will continue to completion.

**General Clean-up:** Crews will be grading, placing topsoil and seed in disturbed areas throughout the project.

**Traffic:** One way alternating traffic will be maintained. Traffic will be encouraged to use either Dog River Road or Derby Drive while this work is occurring. Traffic wanting to travel through the construction zone should expect delays.

**It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.**
