

# Pool 2021 Season FAQ

Published June 2, 2021



All of the following content may change depending on the final decisions of the City Council and staffing availability.

## 1. 2021 POOL HOURS

- a. Hours will be highly dependent on the availability of trained lifeguards- the City will share updates as needed!
- b. Mondays - Fridays:
  - i. Morning Lap Swim (Must Hold a Season Pass): 7:00 - 8:00 am
  - ii. General Swim: 1:00 - 4:15 pm
  - iii. Family Swim: 4:30 - 7:00 pm
- c. Saturdays & Sundays:
  - i. General Swim: 1:00 - 5:30 pm

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Family swim requires an individual to be entering 9th grade or they must be accompanied by someone 18 years of age or older. Children age 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children 4 and under must have an adult IN the water with them.

## 2. WAIVER FORMS

- a. All Pool Pass purchasers and those signing up for Swimming Lessons will need to sign a waiver that acknowledges they will hold the City harmless in case of a COVID outbreak
- b. Waivers will be posted as a flyer/poster at the entrance to the pool- paying to enter the pool assumes agreement with the waiver

## 3. FEE CHANGES

- a. Opening the Pool this summer will mean some obvious changes, to keep the general public and the day-camp separate.
  - i. This will include the City barricading off portions of the pool for camp-use only
    1. One raft will be for Day-Camp use only
    2.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the pool deck and pool will be for Day-Camp use only
  - ii. The Pool-house will be for camp-use only, and closed to the public,
  - iii. Porta-johns will be set up as replacements for the Pool-house restrooms for public use
