

(updated June 15, 2021)

- **COVID-Vaccinated people are no longer required to wear masks or socially distance inside our facility, effective June 15.**
 - “Vaccinated” means all shots complete, and being two-weeks past your last shot.
 - The public will not be asked at the door, nor required to provide evidence of vaccination status at this time; the City has decided on an **honor system**.
- **Un-vaccinated people are still required to wear masks inside our facility, as of June 15, as with all city facilities.**
 - Exception: When eating or drinking, masks may be removed, and people are encouraged to physically distance.
- **Self-screening for symptoms**
 - We ask that all people do self-screening for fevers and other symptoms of illness in advance of arriving. Contactless thermometers are available at the MSAC facility for those needing them.
 - No one should enter our building if they have had recent exposure to a positive case of COVID or symptoms of infectious illness. Reminders are posted on our doors.
 - We reserve the right to ask people to leave the facility if they exhibit symptoms or indicate a positive exposure.
- **Attendance lists will continue for the foreseeable future** for necessary contact tracing.
 - Attendance for groups (drop-ins, classes, etc.) will be done by instructors and facilitators, who will remind people about our guidelines.
 - People arriving for solo or miscellaneous activities or customer service are asked to sign in at the entrance.
