

**Vermont Farm to Family Program
2021 COUPON ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION SITES**

A family with someone who is at least six months old and enrolled in the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program will receive their Farm to Family coupons through WIC. Vermont Department of Health offices notify WIC families about coupon availability.

Any other household should contact their Community Action Agency to learn when and where to apply for coupons. Coupons are provided at the same time the application is submitted. Coupon distribution begins July 1 and lasts until coupons run out, which is quickly in some areas. To qualify for a \$30 book of Farm to Family coupons, a household must have gross income at or below these levels:
